Dear Ms. Callahan:

I am submitting the enclosed amended Desired Future Conditions ("DFCs") of the groundwater resources in Groundwater Management Area 6 ("GMA 6"), pursuant to Section 36.108 of the Texas Water Code. Groundwater Management Area 6 ("GMA 6") is comprised of four groundwater conservation districts in North Central Texas: Clear Fork Groundwater Conservation District, Gateway Groundwater Conservation District, Mesquite Groundwater Conservation District, and Rolling Plains Groundwater Conservation District. The member districts of GMA 6 have worked together over the past few years, in coordination with the Texas Water Development Board, to unanimously adopt initial DFCs that will protect and conserve the groundwater resources of North Central Texas.

The GMA 6 DFCs are based on the Texas Water Plan and the Texas Water Development Board's applicable Groundwater Availability Model runs for all relevant aquifers within the boundaries of Groundwater Management Area 6: the Ogallala, Dockum, Blaine, and Seymour Aquifers. The GMA recognized that Pod 1 of the Seymour Aquifer in Childress County that is located in Gateway Groundwater Conservation District is considered not relevant for planning purposes in GMA 6, as noted in Resolution 2011-002 (see attached meeting minutes for the July 19, 2011 GMA 6 meeting).

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-001

OF GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREA 6 ADOPTING DESIRED FUTURE CONDITIONS FOR PORTIONS OF THE BLAINE AQUIFER

WHEREAS, Groundwater Management Area 6 (“GMA-6”) is comprised of twenty six counties located in North Central Texas and encompasses four groundwater conservation districts – the Clear Fork Groundwater Conservation District (“Clear Fork District”), the Gateway Groundwater Conservation District (“Gateway District”), the Mesquite Groundwater Conservation District (“Mesquite District”), and the Rolling Plains Groundwater Conservation District (“Rolling Plains District”);

WHEREAS, GMA-6 unanimously supports the following goals, ideals and standards for GMA-6. The GMA-6 member Districts have worked to learn the rules and goals of each individual district, and the adjoining Groundwater Conservation Districts in GMA-1, GMA-2, GMA-7 and GMA-8 along with the history of how each District has arrived at their different management philosophies. The members of GMA-6 agree and support the Desired Future Conditions (“DFCs”) as set out below. These conditions are viewed only as starting points for GMA-6 to go forth for the next five years as charged. The members of GMA-6 agree that monitoring is necessary to measure the depths and scope of the Blaine Aquifer, where it exists, and to manage these groundwater resources to achieve these DFCs;

WHEREAS, pursuant to TEXAS WATER CODE ANN. § 36.108, the presiding officer, or his designee, from each of the four Districts in GMA-6 are obligated to engage in ongoing joint planning to, among other things, establish the DFCs of the aquifers within GMA-6;

WHEREAS, such joint planning has been undertaken, and is ongoing, by the four presiding officers or designees of the Districts;

WHEREAS, the representatives of the Districts in GMA-6 have met as required by Section 36.108 of the Texas Water Code for joint planning not only to set the initial DFCs,

WHEREAS, the Blaine Aquifer consists of substantially different characteristics and conditions across its boundaries and pursuant to TEXAS WATER CODE ANN. § 36.108, when considering the adoption of DFCs, GMA-6 is obligated to and has considered the “uses or conditions of an aquifer within the GMA that differ substantially from one area to another” and may adopt different DFCs for different areas overlying an aquifer;

WHEREAS, GMA-6 carefully studied the DFC established by GMA 1 when determining the DFCs for the Blaine Aquifer;

WHEREAS, GMA-6 also believes the DFCs to be generally consistent with the 2006 Panhandle and Regions B & G Regional Water Plans and the 2007 State Water Plan;

WHEREAS, the DFCs adopted by the GMA on this date are subject to revision in the future;

WHEREAS, the GMA desires to honor the mandates of Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code, including private property rights, and desires to treat everyone in a reasonable manner given the extreme diversity through the area;

WHEREAS, the GMA desires to inform the citizens of the Management Area about the Blaine Aquifer, the diversity of the aquifer and its uses and conditions, and the challenges of groundwater management with minimal impact to the local economy;

WHEREAS, the GMA has worked closely with the Texas Water Development Board, their hydrologists and other qualified professionals to base the adopted Desired Future Conditions on the best available science;

WHEREAS, the GMA is striving towards the intent of the joint planning process and is fully committed to continuing this important process and achieving the ultimate goal to conserve and preserve the aquifer;

WHEREAS, the GMA has reviewed the results of additional studies of the Blaine Aquifer outlined in GAM Task 11-006,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREA 6 THAT:

1. All the preceding statements formed the basis for the decision by the Groundwater Management Area Representatives to adopt on this date, the DFCs set forth herein:
2. The following Desired Future Conditions are hereby adopted for the Blaine Aquifer within Groundwater Management Area 6 as described below:
  - a. The Desired Future Condition for that part of Childress County located in the Mesquite Groundwater Conservation District; Collingsworth and Hall counties, also located within the Mesquite Groundwater Conservation District, is that condition whereby 80 percent of the current volume in storage will remain in 50 years (2060);
  - b. All other Desired Future Conditions adopted in GMA 6 Resolution 2010-004 remain as stated in that resolution.

GMA-6 recognizes that each District's boundaries may change due to the consolidation or annexation of land in GMA 6 that is either in or out of a district, therefore, the consolidated or annexed land will follow the rules, regulations, and Desired Future Conditions of the receiving District. The members of GMA 6 **unanimously** agree that these are the goals for the DFCs in GMA-6 for the next five years.

3. These DFCs shall become effective on the date indicated below and shall remain in effect for five years, unless modified or repealed sooner by the GMA in accordance with applicable law.
4. The members of the Groundwater Management Area 6 agree to continue to work in





good faith on joint planning efforts in a manner consistent with applicable law.


5. All Districts in Groundwater Management Area 6 are unified in fulfilling the charge, set forth in Section 36.0015, Texas Water Code, to “provide for the conservation, preservation, protection, recharging, and prevention of waste of groundwater, and of groundwater reservoirs or their subdivisions, and to control subsidence caused by withdrawal of water from those groundwater reservoirs or their subdivisions, consistent with the objectives of Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, groundwater conservation districts may be created as provided by this chapter. Groundwater conservation districts created as provided by this chapter are the state's preferred method of groundwater management through rules developed, adopted, and promulgated by a district in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.”

OF GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREA 6 REVISING PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED DESIRED FUTURE CONDITIONS FOR THE SEYMOUR AQUIFER IN CHILDRRESS COUNTY

WHEREAS, Groundwater Management Area 6 (“GMA-6”) is comprised of twenty six counties located in North Central Texas and encompasses four groundwater conservation districts – the Clear Fork Groundwater Conservation District (“Clear Fork District”), the Gateway Groundwater Conservation District (“Gateway District”), the Mesquite Groundwater Conservation District (“Mesquite District”), and the Rolling Plains Groundwater Conservation District (“Rolling Plains District”);

WHEREAS, GMA-6 unanimously adopted Desired Future Conditions for the Seymour and other aquifers on 22 July 2010:

WHEREAS, pursuant to TEXAS WATER CODE ANN. § 36.108, the presiding officer, or his designee, from each of the four Districts in GMA-6 are obligated to engage in ongoing joint planning to, among other things, establish the DFCs of the aquifers within GMA-6;

WHEREAS, such joint planning has been undertaken, and is ongoing, by the four presiding officers or designees of the Districts;

WHEREAS, the joint planning and subsequent analysis by the Texas Water Development Board’s Groundwater Availability Model has shown that there are incompatible goals in the Childress County portion of Pod 1 of the Seymour Aquifer;

WHEREAS, GMA-6 has studied the results of the TWDB GAM Task 11-006;

WHEREAS, the DFCs adopted by the GMA on 22 July 2010 were subject to future revision;

WHEREAS, the GMA desires to modify the DFC for Pod 1 in Childress County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AREA 6 THAT:

1. All the preceding statements formed the basis for the decision by the Groundwater Management Area Representatives to adopt on this date, the DFC set forth herein:
2.
  - a. That part of Pod 1 in Childress County that is located in Gateway Groundwater Conservation District is considered not relevant for planning purposes.
  - b. The Desired Future Condition for all other areas of the Seymour aquifer remain as adopted 22 July 2010.
3. These DFCs shall become effective on the date indicated below and shall remain in effect for five years, unless modified or repealed sooner by the GMA in accordance


with applicable law.

4. The members of the Groundwater Management Area 6 will continue to work in good faith on joint planning efforts in a manner consistent with applicable law.
