DISTRIBUTION OF DETECTED HISTORICAL NITRATE CONCENTRATIONS BY RANGE IN CONCENTRATION CATEGORIES FOR THE MIDDLE TRINITY AQUIFER

- EXPLANATION**
- Nitrate concentration at ambient level of 1.0 mg/l or less
 - Nitrate concentration greater than ambient level but equal to or less than 10.6 mg/l which is regional average nitrate concentration of the ground waters of the Hill Country study area
 - ▲ Nitrate concentration greater than regional average concentration of 10.6 mg/l but equal to or less than 44.3 mg/l which is primary drinking water standard MCL for nitrate
 - * Nitrate concentration greater than primary drinking water standard MCL of 44.3 mg/l for nitrate
