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INTRODUCTION

On September 1, 1965 the Texas Water Commission (formerly, before February 1962, the State Board of Water Engineers) experienced a far-reaching realignment of functions and personnel, directed toward the increased emphasis needed for planning and developing Texas' water resources and for administering water rights. Realigned and concentrated in the Texas Water Development Board were the investigative, planning, development, research, financing, and supporting functions, including the reports review and publication functions. The name Texas Water Commission was changed to Texas Water Rights Commission, and responsibility for functions relating to water-rights administration was vested therein.

This circular lists only those publications held and distributed by the Texas Water Development Board. It contains listings of all Bulletins, Circulars, Memorandum Reports, Limited-Distribution Reports, and Water-Resources Planning Reports formerly printed and distributed by its predecessors, as well as most of the miscellaneous unnumbered reports and reports of the State Reclamation Department. Also listed are the three series of the Texas Water Development Board--Reports, Circulars, and a Planning Series--printed after the September 1, 1965 realignment.

For convenience to the user of these lists, a county and river basin location map is shown on the following page. An index of publications has also been included at the end of this report as an aid in determining which reports pertain to particular subjects and areas.

An asterisk (*) before the publication number on the following pages indicates that the publication is out of print and not available for distribution; however, most of these may be reviewed in the library of the Water Development Board. Information shown in brackets is explanatory in nature and not a part of a publication title. Reprint dates where applicable are shown in parentheses.

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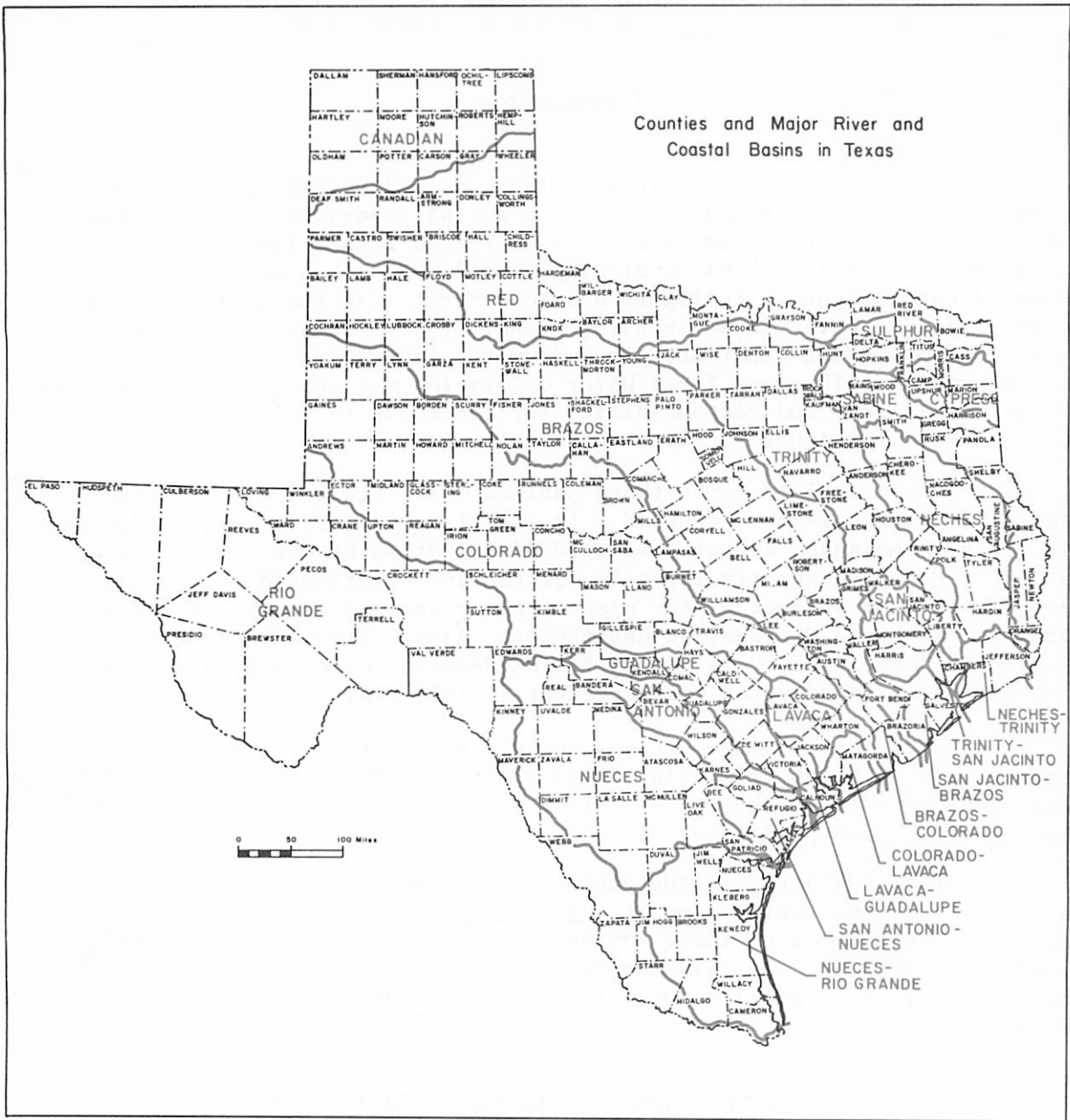

Under the provisions of Senate Bill 398 of the Fifty-second Legislature in 1962, the Board of Water Engineers was assigned the powers and duties of the State Reclamation Engineer; the Water Development Board now distributes these reports.

The Texas Water Development Board is presently engaged in the preparation of a comprehensive State Water Plan, as directed by Governor Connally and by Senate Bill 146 of the Fifty-Ninth Legislature. Many of the technical reports of this Agency were prepared primarily to make available basic data necessary to the preparation of such a plan (see Index).
