Three goals drive the effort to create the first State Flood Assessment, a forthcoming report by the Texas Water Development Board:

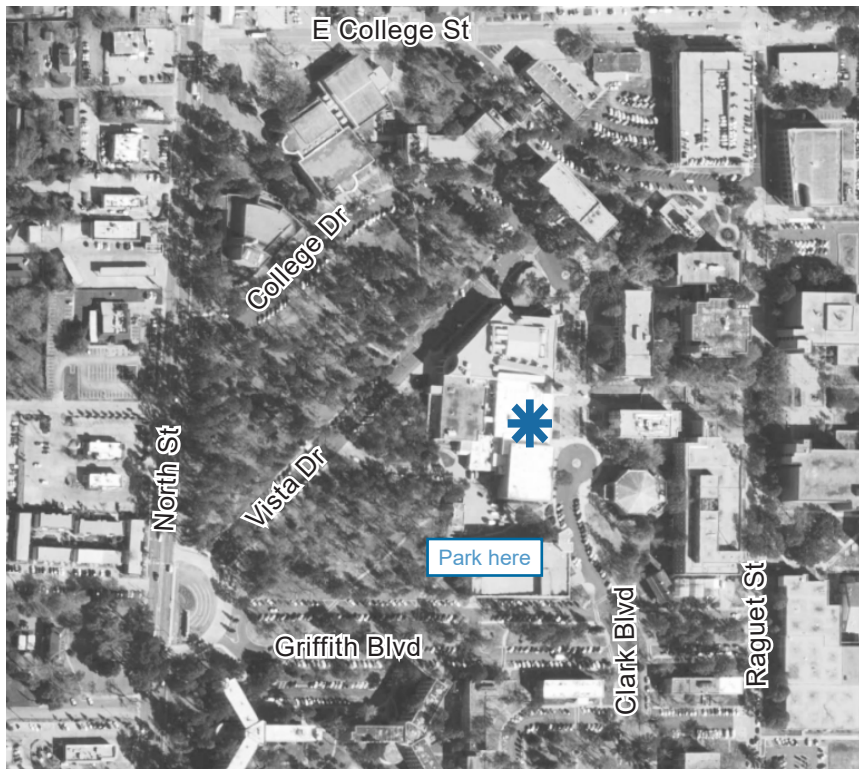
1. assess risks and roles;
